- Building 205 was noted as a building of interest on a list provided by Barry Silber of the CECOM Safety Office (Ref. 045).
- CECOM Safety inventory lists (Ref. 047) include the presence of explosives detectors and their associated Ni-63 sources.

During the site visit, two vapor tracers and one Itemiser 3 (explosives detectors containing Ni-63) were identified and are being kept in storage in Room 136 of this building. They are currently not in regular service. Swipe tests/leak tests are done regularly on these instruments, with no evidence of leaks on record (Ref. 022).
