FMERA

- Independent Authority of the State of New Jersey
- Recognized by the DoD as the Local Redevelopment Authority (LRA)
- Funded by DoD Office of Economic Adjustment (and sales proceeds/EDC funding)
- Environmental Staff Advisory Committee
- NJDEP representative on FMERA Board and Chairs ESAC along with Fort Monmouth Case Manager





STATUS:

- Army vacated 9/15/2011
- FMERA negotiating transition plan (Phase 1 & Phase 2)
- Army working on environmental responsibilities w/NJDEP
- FMERA attracting investors/employers
- Army/FMERA executed MOA for Phase 1 on May 17, 2012
- Storm Sandy Initiatives

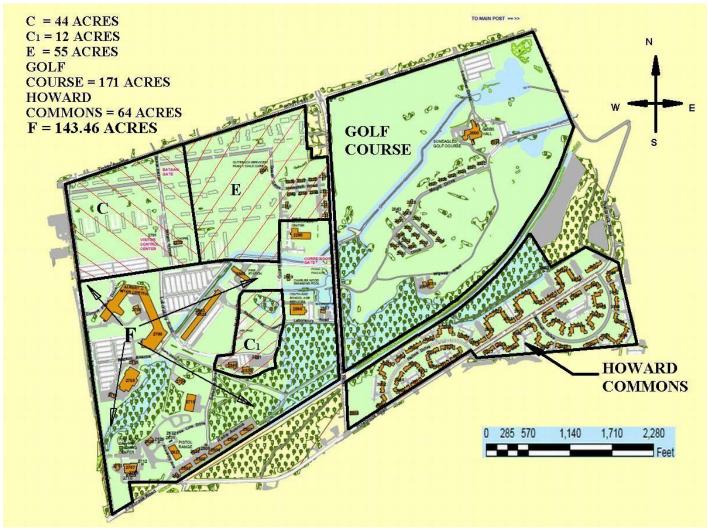


Status of Transfer Process with Army

- Phase 1 Memorandum of Agreement Signed May 2012
 - Encompasses all of the Charles Wood Area, select parcels on the Main Post
 - Allows for leases of specific buildings that are in Phase 2
- Economic Development Conveyance Phase 1
 Application Approved June, 2012
- Currently negotiating Phase 2 with the Army

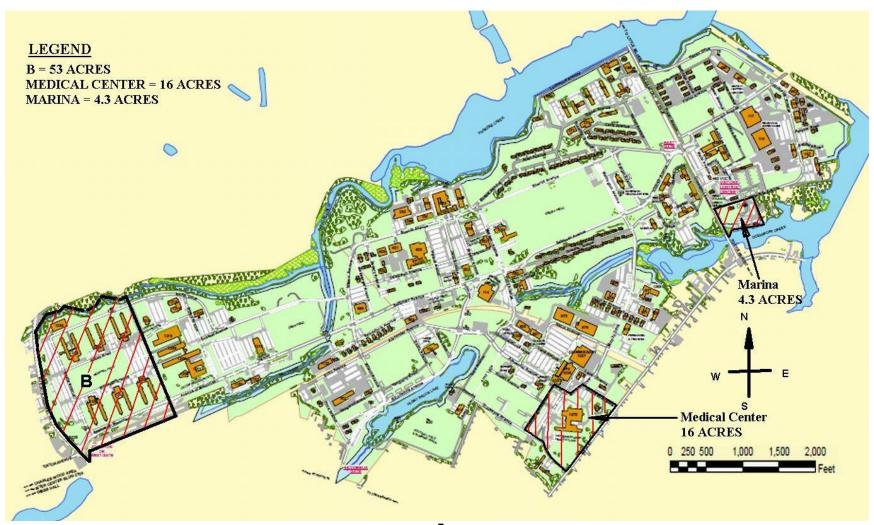


EDC Phase One Parcels Charles Wood

Closed and Pending Transfers

- Closed on Parcel E, 55 Acres with CommVault Systems (Currently under construction)
- Signed Purchase and Sale Agreement on the Clinic Parcel with Acutecare Healthcare Systems – expect to close in July/August
- Expect all of Parcel F and Parcel B to transfer to FMERA by January 2014

- Howard Commons Housing
 - Issued 12/14/2012
 - Proposals Due 1/28/2013
 - 6 Firms submitted 9 proposals currently under review
- Officer Housing
 - Issued 1/16/2013
 - Proposals Due 4/1/2013
 - 2 proposals received and under review
- Parcels C, C1 and B
 - Issued March 26, 2013
 - Proposals were due June 10, 2013

FMERA Goals

- 1. Job Creation
- 2. Re-investment of sale proceeds
- 3. Ensure <u>ARMY</u> resolves environmental issues
- 4. Satisfied Stakeholders



RFP

- Tasks cannot replicate tasks performed by the Army
- Army works directly with NJDEP and is responsible for remediation (unless FMERA enters into an Environmental Services Cooperative Agreement ESCA or agrees to an Early Transfer which would require the Governor's signature)



RFP Timeline

- Q/A Deadline July 18, 2013 5:00 PM
- Issue Addendum on or about July 26, 2013 (attendees will get an email notification when it is posted to: www.fortmonmouthredevelopment.com
- Proposals due August 2, 2013 at Noon
- Board Approval of Selected Firm August 21, 2013 (Tentative)
- Contract Award upon expiration of Governor's veto period (on or about September 13, 2013
